






















Pipe Chime Labels

Print out the following labels and cut them into individual rectangles. Carefully wrap the labels around the upper part of your chimes (between the top of the chime and the hole for the holding string). Cut to size a piece of clear boxing tape that is slightly wider and longer than the label. Wrap the label around the chime and attach it with tape so that it is completely covered along all sides. This will prevent the label from catching on anything and protect the label from scuffing against other chimes. Chime #0 is the longest chime in length; #22 is the shortest.
